

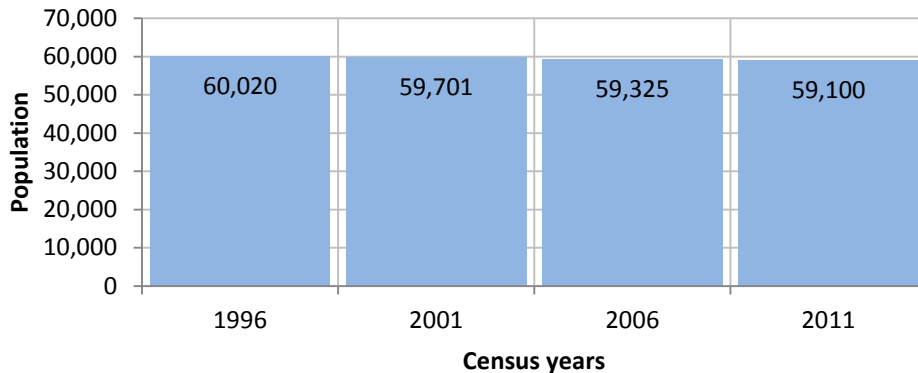

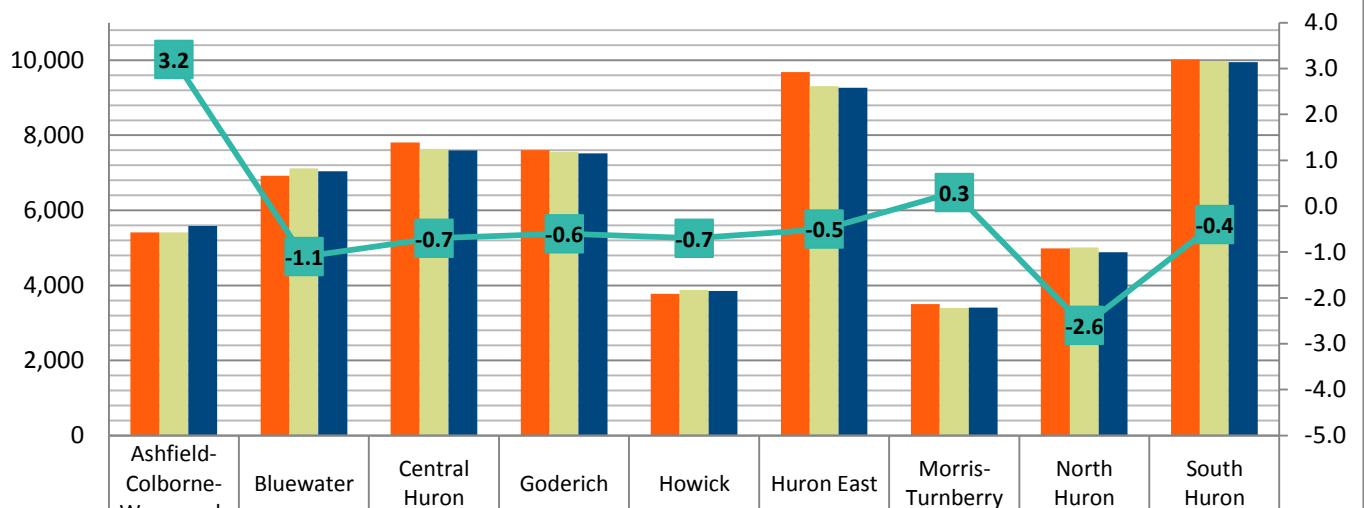
Huron County Population Change 1996 - 2011

- South Huron

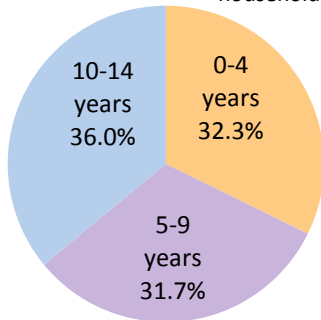

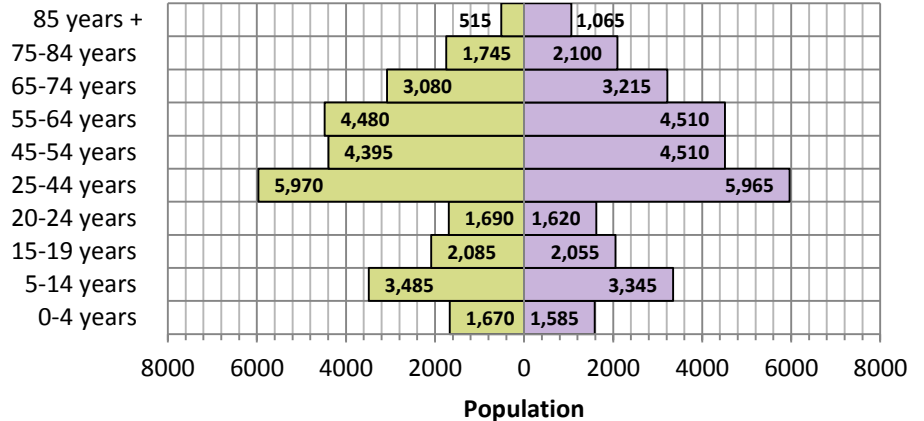
Age distribution of children in Huron County 2011

Average number of children per household: 1.0



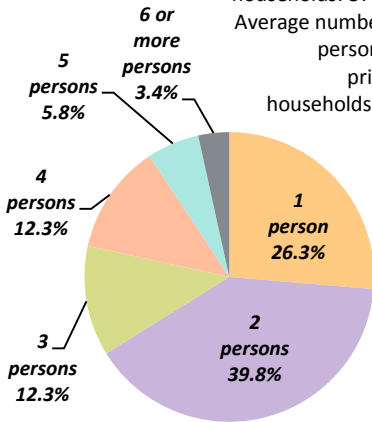
Huron County Population Pyramid, 2011

Male Female



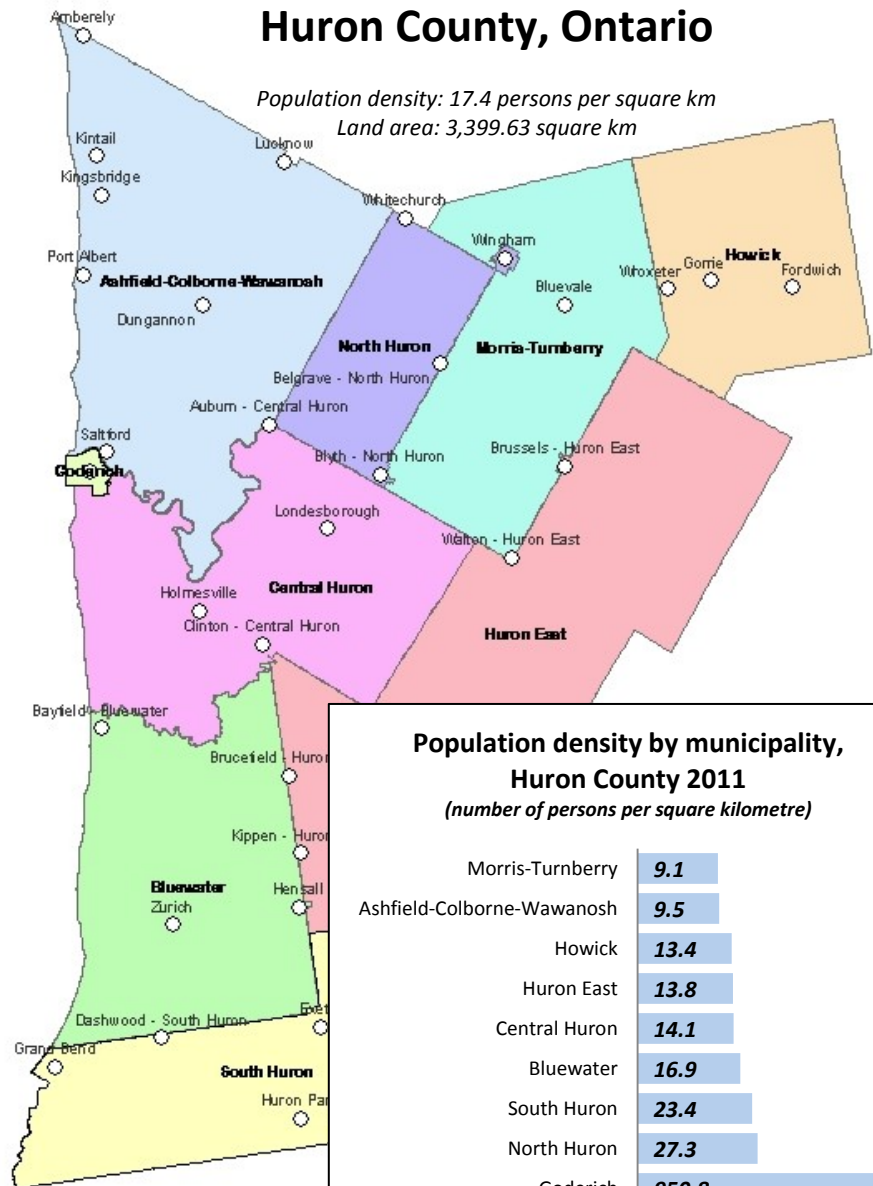
Percentage of households by household size

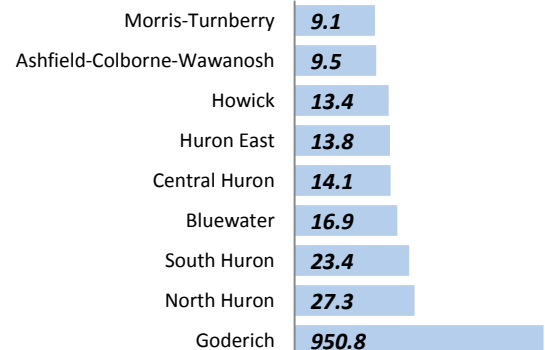
