United Way Perth-Huron supports youth (ages 14–24) with big ideas and a passion for positive change in Perth and Huron Counties.

What Kind of Projects Are We Looking For?

We fund youth-led projects that:

- ✓ Are created and led by youth from Perth or Huron Counties
- ✓ Involve youth in shaping solutions
- ✓ Address important youth or community issues
- ✓ Share youth perspectives on local challenges
- ✓ Are creative and goal-driven
- ✓ Aim to make an impact
- ✓ Are legal, safe, inclusive, and accessible

Examples of Past Projects

- ✓ Wellness Wednesdays: Weekly workshops on wellness topics
- ✓ The Art Cart: Free art supplies for all students
- ✓ Career Workshop: Helping students explore post-grad options
- ✓ Create an outdoor learning space
- ✓ Youth Mentoring: Pairing younger and older students
- ✓ Student-led meal and cooking program

Project Ideas

- ✓ Conflict resolution teams
- ✓ Mental health or mindfulness workshops
- ✓ Financial literacy sessions
- ✓ Mental health lending libraries
- ✓ Student magazine on youth issues
- ✓ Mural projects or art exhibits
- ✓ Non-competitive sports for fun and inclusion
- ✓ Environmental sustainability initiatives

Who Can Apply?

- ✓ Youth Lead Applicant: Age 14–24
- ✓ Adult Trustee: Age 25+ to help with budgeting and reporting (Funds are paid to the Adult Trustee or their organization)

What Can the Grant Be Used For?

- ✓ Guest speakers, materials, promotional costs
- Workshop supplies, food, printing
- Short-term equipment or facility rentals

X Not eligible for:

- Adult-led or recreational-only projects
- Fundraising, cash prizes, or gift cards
- Staff salaries, web dev, or marketing
- Projects benefiting only a few people
- Travel or saving money for later

Applications must include a clear budget and project plan.

How & When to Apply

- Apply between: September 19 October 20, 2025
- Form available at: perthhuron.unitedway.ca

① Apply early! Early applications may receive helpful feedback and a chance to revise.

What Happens After You Apply?

- November Our staff may contact you with questions. You'll receive a decision by the end of the month.
- December to May Run your project! Keep us in the loop and take photos if you can.
- June 2026 Submit your final report and return any unused funds.

If Your Project is Funded

- 1. Sign the contract (you and your Adult Trustee).
- 2. Receive 100% of the grant upfront.
- 3. Complete the project by May 31, 2026.
- 4. Submit your final report and return unused funds by June 14, 2026.
- 5. After reviewing, receive the remaining 10% of your grant.

Information for Teachers

Want to involve your class? Great!

Now it works:

- Divide the class into teams of 3-5. Each team applies.
- Even if only some teams are funded, you can merge efforts.
- Work toward a semester timeline projects should be ready to launch by early November and wrap by May.

Applications Open: September 19, 2025
Applications Due: October 20, 2025
Decisions Announced: Late November
Projects Completed By: June 1, 2026
Final Reports Due: June 30, 2026
